Well the year is off to a great start and we're out riding with three events under our belts thanks to our road captains and activities committee. The weather has been a little cool but don't let that deter you. After all, you spent good, hard earned dollars for that winter gear so put it on and come ride with us. I'm excited about the new ECHOG year. We're going to do new things, going to new places, going to see lots of new members, going to ride with new road captains, and going to have tons of old fashion fun.

Whether you ride when it's cold or wait until it's warmer to saddle up please make sure to check your equipment before you roll out. Cold temperatures are hard on batteries. A battery tender is a good investment to keep yours fully charged and ready to go. And your battery will last longer. Tires tend to lose air during the winter months so check your tire pressure regularly and keep them properly inflated. Proper tire pressure doesn't only prolong tire life it also makes you safer. Under inflated tires will cause your bike to handle squirrely. Over inflated tires will result in less traction as your contact patch becomes smaller. Either condition will shorten the life span of your tires. Check the calendar, dust off the bike, fill it up with gas and let's ride and have fun. Ken Higginbotham

Ken Higginbotham (Head Road Captain & Safety Officer)

- Rides Upcoming rides/activities include: 01/09 Brunch ride to Barnwood Grill; 01/14 Dinner ride to Bleu Voodoo Grill; 01/30 SC Whole HOG chili cook-off at Low Country Harley Davidson; 02/06 Sweetheart ride to O'Charley's (ride after lunch); 02/18 ROMEO ride to Mac's Speed Shop; and 02/13 Shealy's BBQ; 02/16 Victory Valley Vineyards. Refer to calendar for event details, updates or cancellations.
- **Responsibility of Riding in a Group** Don't do anything that jeopardizes someone else's safety, such as an unexpected or sudden move. Ride in a tight pack, particularly at traffic lights. Be on time (10-15 minutes before scheduled departure). Arrive with a full tank of gas. Be prepared mentally and physically. Know hand signals (left hand or right foot for dangers in the road). Passengers watch your hands so as not to confuse riders behind you. Ken explained the "Bread Crumb" technique. If the group is separated, the bikes continue in a pack until a turn is made. Then the last bike will find a safe place to pull over until the other bikes catch up. This process continues each time a turn is made until all bikes are back together. It is also recommended that when the group is separated that each bike should blow their horn to alert the road captain. Typically trikes ride near the back of the pack in the center lane. The next bike behind the trike will ride in the appropriate position (staggered with the bike ahead).
