Members willing to be involved in whatever duties are required to keep things running to me is how it should be,

and how a great family should function. I love when there is camaraderie within, and so far I have seen lots of it. We have chosen a great charity this year from amongst a lot of good ones. March 5th kicked our fund raising drive, and in one day we raised \$40 while doing what we love best, riding! I was honored to be the Road Captain on the day we kicked it off. The first event our Charity Committee selected works in the following manner. The Road Captain of the ride asks members at the pre-trip briefing if anyone wishes to do a 50/50 game. The participating members pay \$5 that forms the funds for the 50/50. At some point of the ride (RC choice) when the bikes are parked, a dice is rolled with numbers on it from 1 to 12. The number rolled relates to a clock (1 o'clock thru 12 o'clock). The riders front wheel viewed from the right side and its valve stem determine the position as it relates to a clock. In case of a tie, there is a roll off between those who tied. On the first event, of 19 bikes we only had 2 tied and very close. This is going to a fun way to raise funds folks! The reason I mentioned this as the first event is because we may have other forms of raising money similar to this.

We have set records of turn out for monthly chapter meetings, a flurry of folks paying annual dues and a good number of new members joining our group. 2016 sure looks bright from the front of the room where I stand each month. You members rock!!......so let's ride!

## **Riding with the Head Road Captain**

Whether you ride when it's cold or wait until it's warmer to saddle up please make sure to check your equipment before you roll out. Cold temperatures are hard on batteries. A battery tender is a good investment to keep yours fully charged and ready to go. And your battery will last longer. Tires tend to lose air during the winter months so check your tire pressure regularly and keep them properly inflated. Proper tire pressure doesn't only prolong tire life it also makes you safer. Under inflated tires will cause your bike to handle squirrely. Over inflated tires will result in less traction as your contact patch becomes smaller. Either condition will shorten the life span of your tires.

Check the calendar, dust off the bike, fill it up with gas and let's ride and have fun. Ken Higginbotham

## **Officers Reports**

#### **Tim Jones (Director)**

- **Welcome** Tim welcomed everyone to the March meeting.
- March Birthdays Acknowledged members who have a birthday this month by singing Happy Birthday.
- **Membership Dues Cutoff** Anyone who doesn't renew by the March 1<sup>st</sup> will be removed from the membership list.
- **Demo Fleet Rides** Tim thanked those who volunteered for the Demo rides and the "Hot Dog Ladies" for their hard work. Rocky really appreciated the support from the Chapter.
- **Membership Drive** Tim also thanked Pam Waitekus, Melissa Clemons and any others who helped with the membership drive during the Demo Fleet rides. We had 1 member renew.
- **Mileage Challenge** Begins 03/01/2016 11/01/16. Mileage must be verified by a Chapter Primary Officer or Timms employee. There will be a challenge for Full-time employed members and Retired members. Tim reviewed the general rules for the challenge. Mileage must be on a Harley Davidson motorcycle. A separate form is required for each motorcycle. Member must participate in at least 12 Chapter events.
- **Charities** Tim asked if any of the members would like to speak regarding the charities that will be voted on later tonight.
