<u>Riding with the Head Road Captain</u>

Whether you ride when it's cold or wait until it's warmer to saddle up please make sure to check your equipment before you roll out. Cold temperatures are hard on batteries. A battery tender is a good investment to keep yours fully charged and ready to go. And your battery will last longer. Tires tend to lose air during the winter months so check your tire pressure regularly and keep them properly inflated. Proper tire pressure doesn't only prolong tire life it also makes you safer. Under inflated tires will cause your bike to handle squirrely. Over inflated tires will result in less traction as your contact patch becomes smaller. Either condition will shorten the life span of your tires. Check the calendar, dust off the bike, fill it up with gas and let's ride and have fun. Ken Higginbotham

Greg shared stories from some of the children at the Home and the life change that has taken place. He also asked for prayers for a 12 year old girl who had been sexually abused since an early age and is contemplating suicide.
