Riding with the head Road Captain

Spring is just around the corner and we're seeing more and more good riding conditions. I think jacket wearing temperatures are best for an enjoyable ride. It isn't cold enough for leather but you get that nice, warm, comfortable feel of something to hold in just a little heat.

I want to call attention to a couple of small changes you will be seeing in how our rides leave the dealership. The road captain riding sweep will no longer be the first bike to head for the gate at Timms, instead, he/she will be staying behind until all bikes are started and have moved out. At that point the sweep will pass everyone to check and hold traffic at the exit of the rear gate. This will ensure that everyone is ready to roll before the lead road captain pulls into the highway.

Secondly, for the safety of our riders, we are asking everyone to stay to the right of center when staging at the rear gate to allow for incoming traffic, especially cars turning into the dealership.

These are minor issues but should help with getting us started on a day of great riding.

<u>On a safety note:</u> Some of our members may done limited riding during the cooler months so please be aware that you may be a little rusty. It's a good idea to do some solo riding to start to get the feel for the challenges the road brings. Take a few miles to brush up on your skills and get used to your bike again. Also, do a safety check of your tires, brakes, clutch action, and throttle response. And come ride with us.

- ECHOG Ride Guide Ken went over some important items listed in our Ride Guide including but not limited to: Importance of showing up on time and ready to leave. This includes a full tank of gas and empty bladder. When leaving Timm's, stay to the right of the driveway when staging to leave so cars can enter. Requested that if you are on greater than two wheels that you ride toward the back of the column to give the lead Road Captain a better view of the group. Reiterated the procedure and the importance of bread crumbing. Should we have a break down during a ride, the sweep is the only one that should stop to assist and stay with member until issue is repaired or until help arrives. Reiterated that in the event of an accident, absolutely no more than 4 people should stop as this creates a dangerous situation with traffic and could impede the progress of emergency personnel. In the event of an accident, the sweep is in charge of the scene.
- Minor Release Forms Ken discussed the minor release forms. It is important that the release form is signed by the legal guardian. If the release form is not signed by the legal guardian than that child will not be able to participate in the event. The forms are located on the EC HOG website.
