

RIDING WITH THE HEAD ROAD CAPTAIN/SAFETY OFFICER

Most of you know that our chapter has experienced a number of unfortunate accidents in recent weeks. Several members have mentioned to me that I should have a lot to talk about in the meetings because of this. Of course, you know me, I can talk a lot about almost nothing but due to these recent events there are a few points that need to be made.

First of all, safety is a personal responsibility. No one can keep us safe unless we choose to take it seriously and do the things necessary to minimize the likelihood of us having an accident.

Secondly, all accidents are caused. Accidents happen but they don't "just happen". An accident is usually a result of some unexpected occurrence and can be caused by any number of things. When something catches you off guard take a moment to think about why and look for ways to avoid that situation in the future.

Third, there is no secret formula for safety but I believe there are three things that each of us can do to improve the odds of us getting home safely whether we are riding, driving, or taking a walk.

- 1. Always be alert. Complacency or inattention can be deadly. Know what is going on around you at all times, try to anticipate what others may do, and consider how you will react if something becomes a threat.
- 2. Know your skill level and ride within it. Don't take unnecessary risks and don't put yourself into situations that you are not capable of handling. Believe it or not, most of us aren't as good as we think we are.
- 3. Practice to improve your skills. Riding helps us to get better but we all need to take the time to get alone in a parking lot or some other isolated, safe place and challenge ourselves to learn to better control our motorcycle by making tight turns, evasive maneuvers, and practicing braking techniques.

Remember, a better rider is a safer rider. Have fun but please stay safe.
