RIDING WITH THE HEAD ROAD CAPTAIN/SAFETY OFFICER

I hope everyone is having a safe and enjoyable spring. Seems like it has rained almost every weekend this year so far and it has taken it has a toll on our ride schedule. But we have had some good ones and hopefully you have been able to take advantage of those opportunities. I especially liked the Riddle Ride. It was something different and a little bit of a challenge to figure out where we were supposed to go. Everyone found it a fun and friendly competition among the participants.

Anyway, now that the weather is warming up it's a good time to practice our skills as we move toward more challenging rides up in the hills. Remember, a better rider is a safer rider and it pays to be safe. One aspect you may want to bush up on is countersteering. This is the phenomenon where the bike goes left when you push forward on the left handle and right when you push forward on the right one. If you aren't familiar with this concept try it the next time you are in an area with plenty of room to maneuver. Get up to around 35 - 40 mph and push gently on the handlebar grip. The harder you push the more quickly the bike will turn so don't do it too hard until you get comfortable with it.

Countersteering will make you a much better rider on curvy roads. Talk to me about it if you have questions. Also, don't forget to look through the turn and not at the road right in front of you or the edge of the road. The motorcycle will got where you are looking so don't look where you don't want to go.

Make certain to give your bike a periodic check to be sure everything is in good shape. Wear the proper safety equipment and always be alert for every possible occurrence. Safety is a personal responsibility so take it personally and do all that you can to avoid a possibly dangerous situation.

That's it for now. Let's all ride safe and have fun in 2018 and beyond.
