Riding with the Safety Officer

Safety Officer Newsletter Article January 2020

I hope that everyone had a very Merry Christmas and a safe and Happy New Year. Moving into 2020 there are two things we often do; reflect on the year that just ended and consider what the new year may bring. Well, I guess there is a third one, trying to remember it's not 2019 anymore when we type or write the date.

Regarding our chapter, 2019 was an interesting year. A lot of things happened, some fun and happy and others not so much. On the bright side, we did some rides we haven't done in the past, largely thanks to Bruce Reignier's activities planning. Also, we had a much safer riding year than 2018 as I don't recall any members being involved in a motorcycle accident, especially when riding with the chapter. Many of our members bought new bikes and we also added several new faces to the group.

But we lost some longtime friends and former members who passed away and others who are dealing with sickness that has caused them to give up riding. Certainly not as critical, but we also cancelled a record number of rides in 2019 due to weather.

Hopefully 2020 will bring a banner riding year for us and we will continue to ride safely. And, since we have a few months of winter to navigate yet, I'll remind everyone of some of the unique challenges that cold weather riding brings. First, it gets cold so make sure you are dressed properly. It is not enjoyable riding a Harley when you are cold so put on plenty of layers to help keep you warm. Layers also allow you to remove them as the day warms up. Next, realize that your reaction time may be a little slower and dexterity impeded so give yourself more room to maneuver. Braking distance increases slightly due to the hardness of cold rotors and pads. You may want to take more riding breaks because the cold and wind has a cumulative effect on our bodies. The longer we ride the colder we get. And worrying about being cold can cause us to lose focus. From an equipment standpoint remember that

your tires will lose pressure when the temperatures drop so you may want to keep an eye on that.

As always prepare properly and be aware.

Stay safe out there and I hope to see you on the road soon.
