Riding with the Safety Officer

Safety Officer Newsletter Article October 2019

The temperatures are starting to fall and so are the leaves. The scenery while riding in the upper elevations is beautiful this time of year. This is, by far, my favorite time to ride. I like riding in cooler climate, wearing a jacket and gloves, cruising though the curves taking in the seasonal colors. Which brings me to the point of this article; we must watch out for leaves in the road. Leaves can pose as much of a hazard as many other obstacles on the roadway so treat them much the same.

First, be alert. Always the first rule of riding a motorcycle. Know that the potential of encountering fallen leaves in your path is increased and be prepared to take the necessary precautions and actions.

- Look for the path of least danger and take it. Often that will be either near the center line or in the center of your lane where vehicles have blown most of the leaves out of the way.
- Slow your roll, especially if you're in a curve. Common sense of course but it doesn't hurt to remind yourself.
- Reduce your lean angle to maintain the maximum contact patch for your tires.
- Relax your grip to reduce the tension in your arms so you are less likely to make a "knee jerk" reaction which can cause you to lose control.
- Stay off the brakes if possible and only use light pressure if you must brake.
- Breathe normally, or a little more deeply to stay calm and ride on. You should be able to handle these type hazards because you have worked on your skills and are confident in your ability to ride in all kinds of conditions.

Also, it may be a good idea to mention that you should check the air pressure in your tires today. Cooler temperatures will cause your tires to lose pressure and proper pressure helps the handling of your bike.

Remember, a better rider is a safer rider. Have fun and ride safe.




