**FAQ**

**- When are the chapter's meetings?**

We meet on the first Tuesday of each month at Fudruckers Restaurant.

Ladies of Harley meets the third Tuesday of each month.

Be sure to check the event calendar for changes in locations for special events.

**- How do I know what is going on?**

The event calendar on the web page is the best way to keep up with the chapter's schedule.

The schedule is also in the newsletter and on the calendar board at Timms HD.

The message board on the web page is a good source of current information.

**- Who do I make ride suggestions to?**

You can tell any chapter officer but it's best to put it in writing. Email addresses in new member packet. Events are determined based on the anticipated level of interest and logistical practicality.

**- How do I know if a ride is cancelled or changed?**

Schedule changes and cancellations will be communicated on the message board on the web page. If a ride is cancelled due to weather the message board will be updated no less than an hour prior to the ride start time.

The event calendar on the web page is updated frequently with the most current information available.

**- Where do ECHOG rides begin?**

All ECHOG rides begin at Timms Harley Davidson unless otherwise stated on the schedule.

**- How long do rides last?**

Dinner rides typically last approximately 3 hours.

Day rides may last as much as 10 hours depending on the ride destination.

Weekend “overnight” rides run from Friday morning through Sunday afternoon for “two night” rides and from Saturday morning through Sunday afternoon for “single night” rides.

Riders can participate in as much of an event as their schedule allows.

- Can I bring my child or grandchild?

Minors may participate in an event with a signed release by a parent or legal guardian.

Minors may join the chapter under same requirements as adult members. Minors are required to have a release signed by a parent or legal guardian for each event in which they participate.

The guest policy will apply for adult children or grandchildren and they must sign a release.

- Is my guest required to ride a Harley?

No. The road captain or an officer should be notified that you are bringing a guest who is riding a non Harley.

- Are all members required to own or ride a Harley?

No. Full members must own a Harley but associate members can be passengers or ride a non Harley.

-What happens if I don't renew my National H.O.G. Membership?

Your membership in the local chapter is terminated. Your chapter membership can be reinstated by renewing your National H.O.G. Membership.
