Kyle Wyman leads with 4 laps to go and another Indian racer T. O'Hara #29 goes down in turn 7 due to loss of traction in the front end. Kyle Wyman leads the last 3 laps and finishes in 1st place at Road Atlanta in King Of The Baggers.
